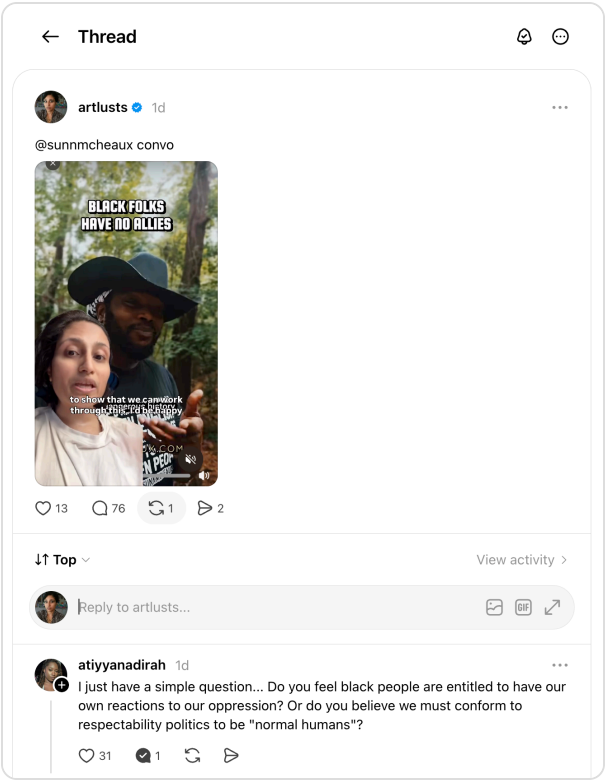

What this is. A screenshot record of your Threads interaction with @sunnmcheaux and your related replies about it, over roughly the last four days (the debate started ~3 days ago).

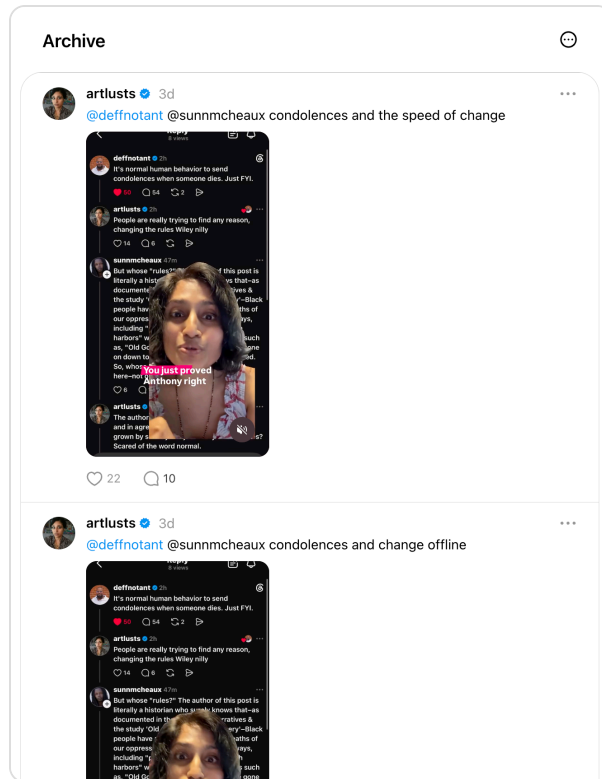
Why his posts mostly aren't shown. You blocked @sunnmcheaux, so his original posts resolve as “Reply to unavailable post” in your archive — only your side is visible. The exception is Section 1: your screen-recorded reply videos captured his actual words in-frame before the block.

Sources. Your public post, your Archive (archived replies), and your live Replies tab (replies still visible with others reacting).

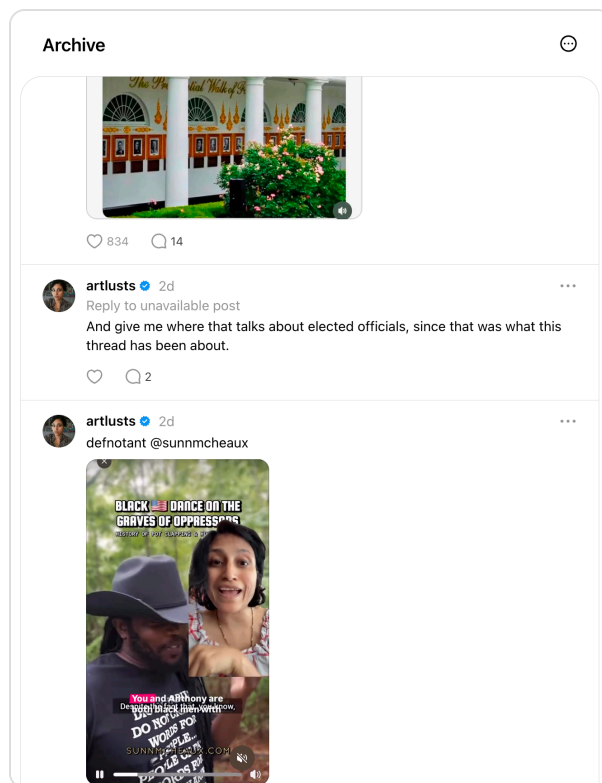
1 · The conversation in your reposts (where his words show)



Your public post captioned “@sunnmcheaux convo” (video). ~1 day ago.



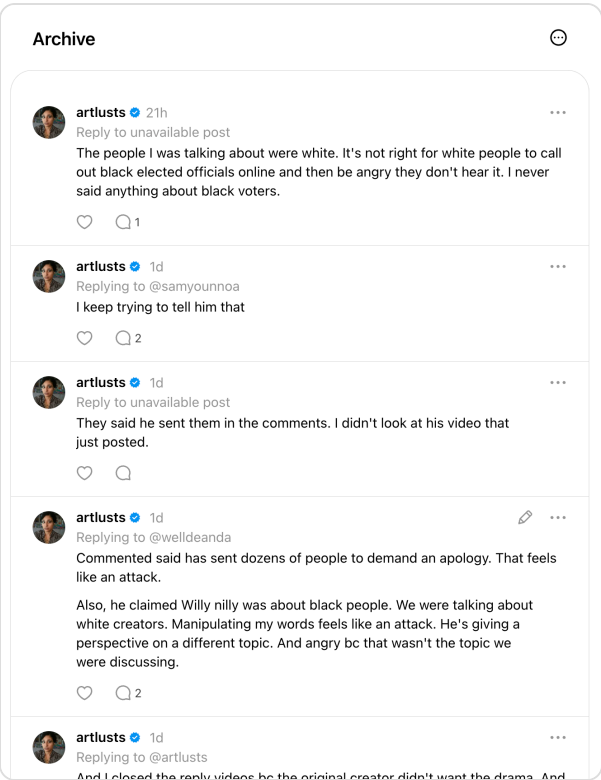

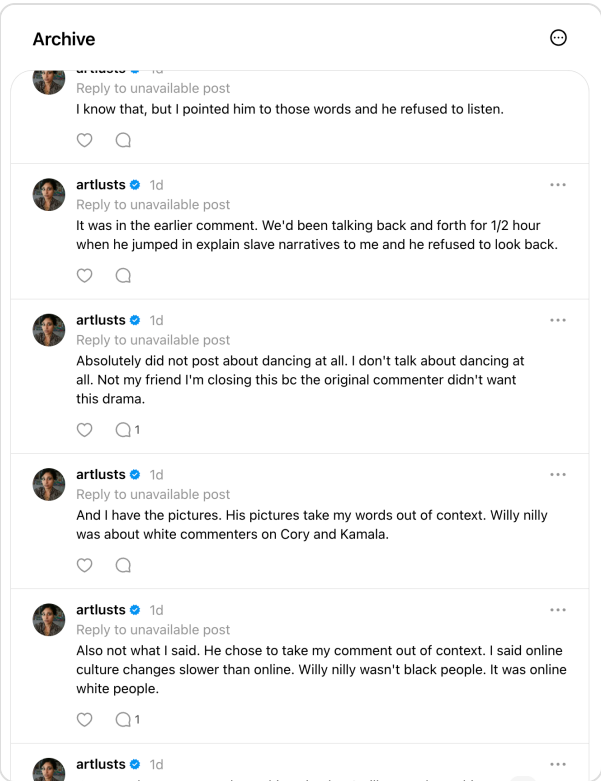

2 · Your replies in the thread (from your Archive)

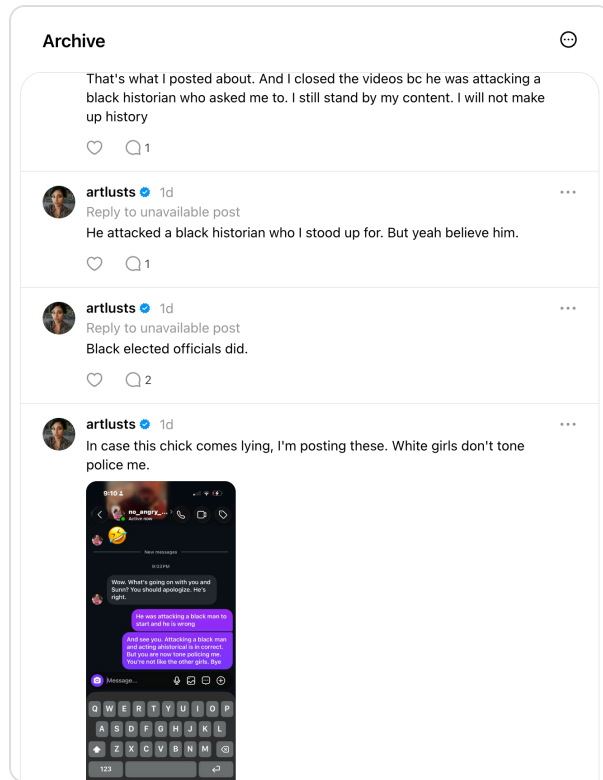
Shown as they appear in your archive — most recent first. The thread began 3 days ago (last image).



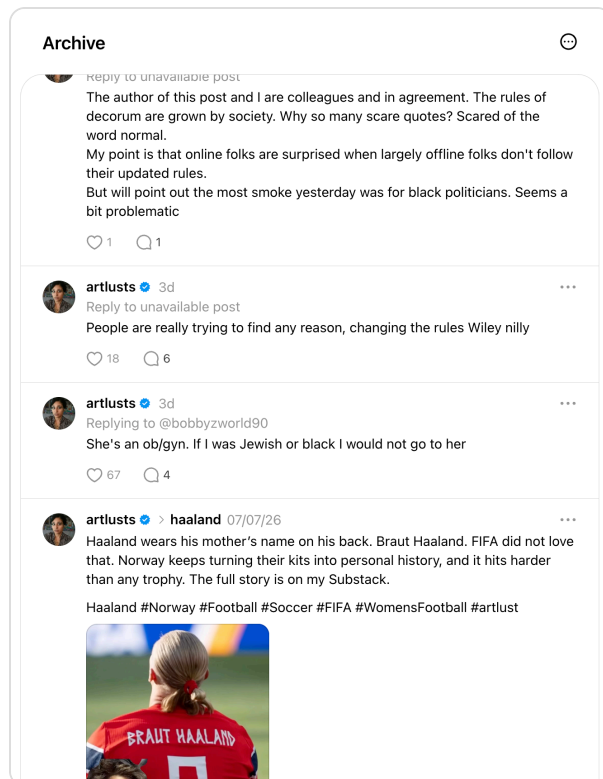

1 day ago — “he jumped in [to] explain slave narratives to me,” “Willy nilly was about white commenters on Cory and Kamala,” closing the thread.

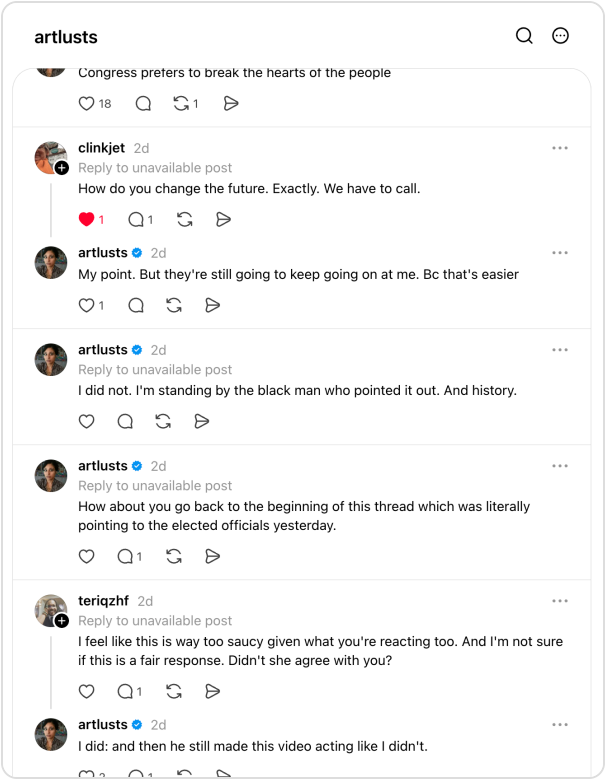

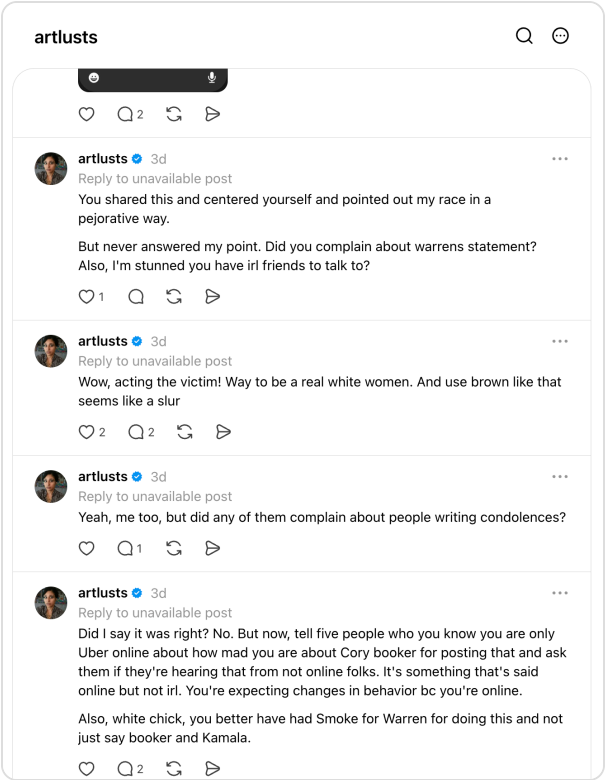


Where it started, 3 days ago — “The author of this post and I are colleagues...” and “changing the rules Wiley nilly.”

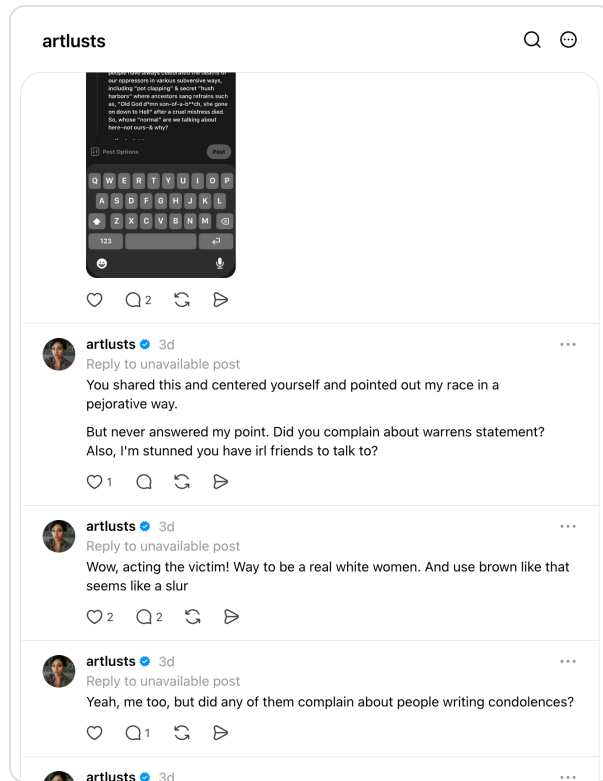
3 · Related replies, with others weighing in (live Replies tab)



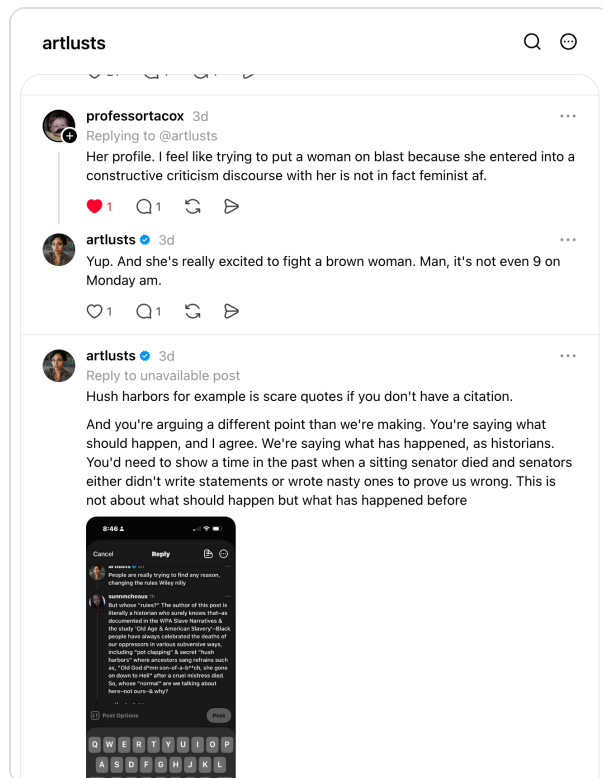
“I’m standing by the black man who pointed it out. And history.” — with clinkjet and teriqrzhf reacting.



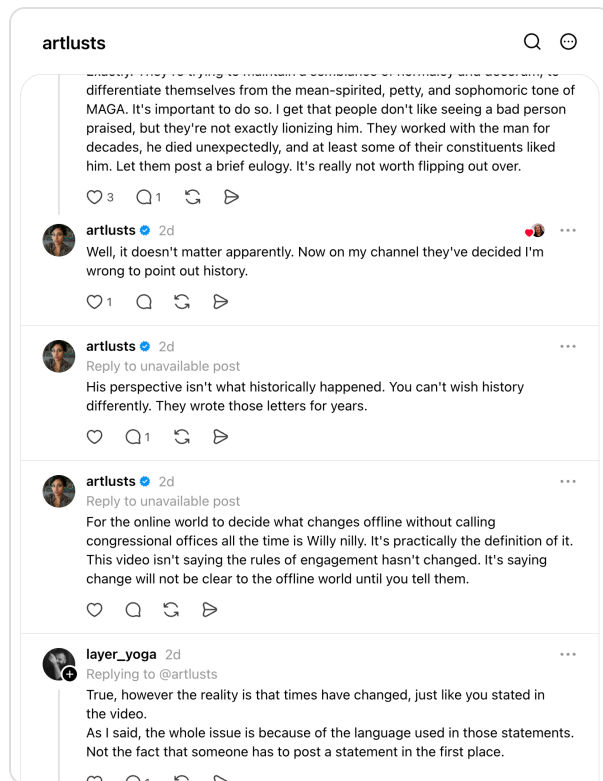
“Wow, acting the victim! Way to be a real white women...”
